Dear friends of children,

During the summer of 1972 I had the opportunity to visit several places in Denmark and Norway where I met many contributors to our cause, and friends of the children at "Mama Paulita". It was a great encouragement for me to meet these friends and know that there are many interested people backing our work.

It has been a very "lean" summer here in the U.S.A. in regard to donations. But we do hope - as we enter into the Fall season - that many of you will remember the children at the orphanage with a donation.

Reports from Mexico tell us that another of the girls - Aracelia Velasquez - has completed her teacher training and has now a position as a rural teacher at Oxaca, south-east of Mexico City. Three little girls were admitted to the home last Spring. Two more will be admitted this September, and in the near future ten more girls will be taken into the home - if the finances permit it. We hope to raise our monthly contributions with an additional \$100 to what we send at the present. This to help out with the expenses for the added responsibility with the new girls. We hope you will join us meeting this responsibility.

While in Norway I met the general secretary of the Norwegian Sunday School Association. He wrote following declaration:

"After reading some brochures about the work of Layman ACTION for Children, Inc., and also having the opportunity to listen to Trygve D. Jansen telling about the work among children in Mexico I cannot but give my very best recommendation. The main impression I have is that this blessed work has been originated by God.
