MOTHER'S DAY - MAY 10th

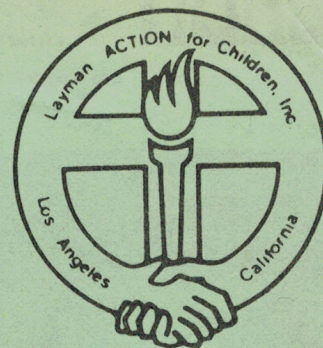

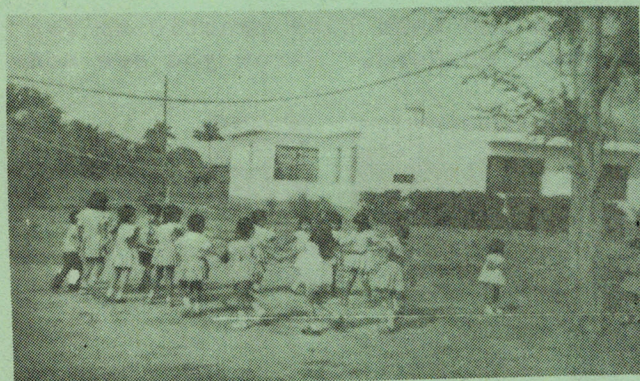

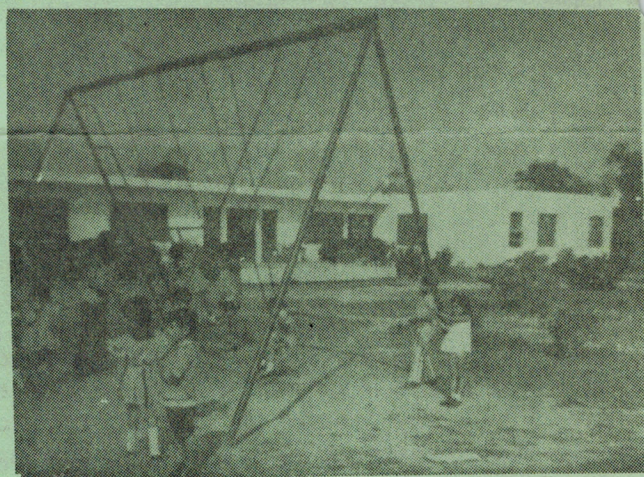

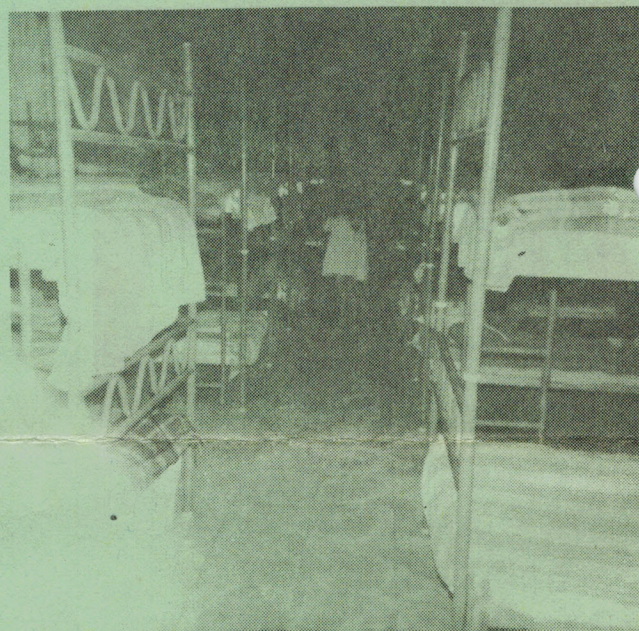
