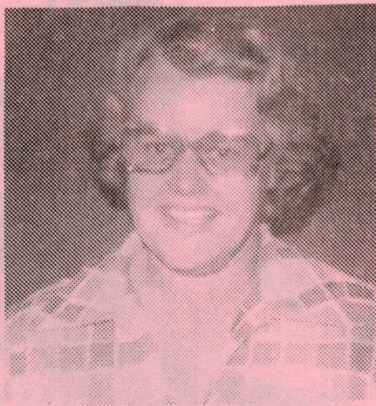

In the beginning only girls were supported. Recently a number of boys have been admitted, and now the boys' home is under construction.

The picture left (below) shows all the girls and boys presently at MAMA PAULITA.

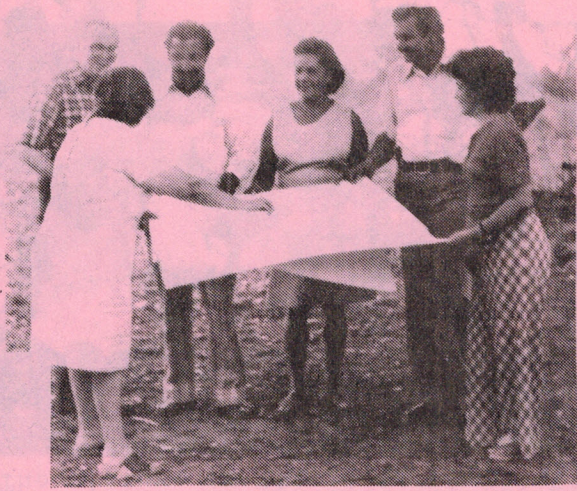
The picture to the right shows the new kindergarden teacher.

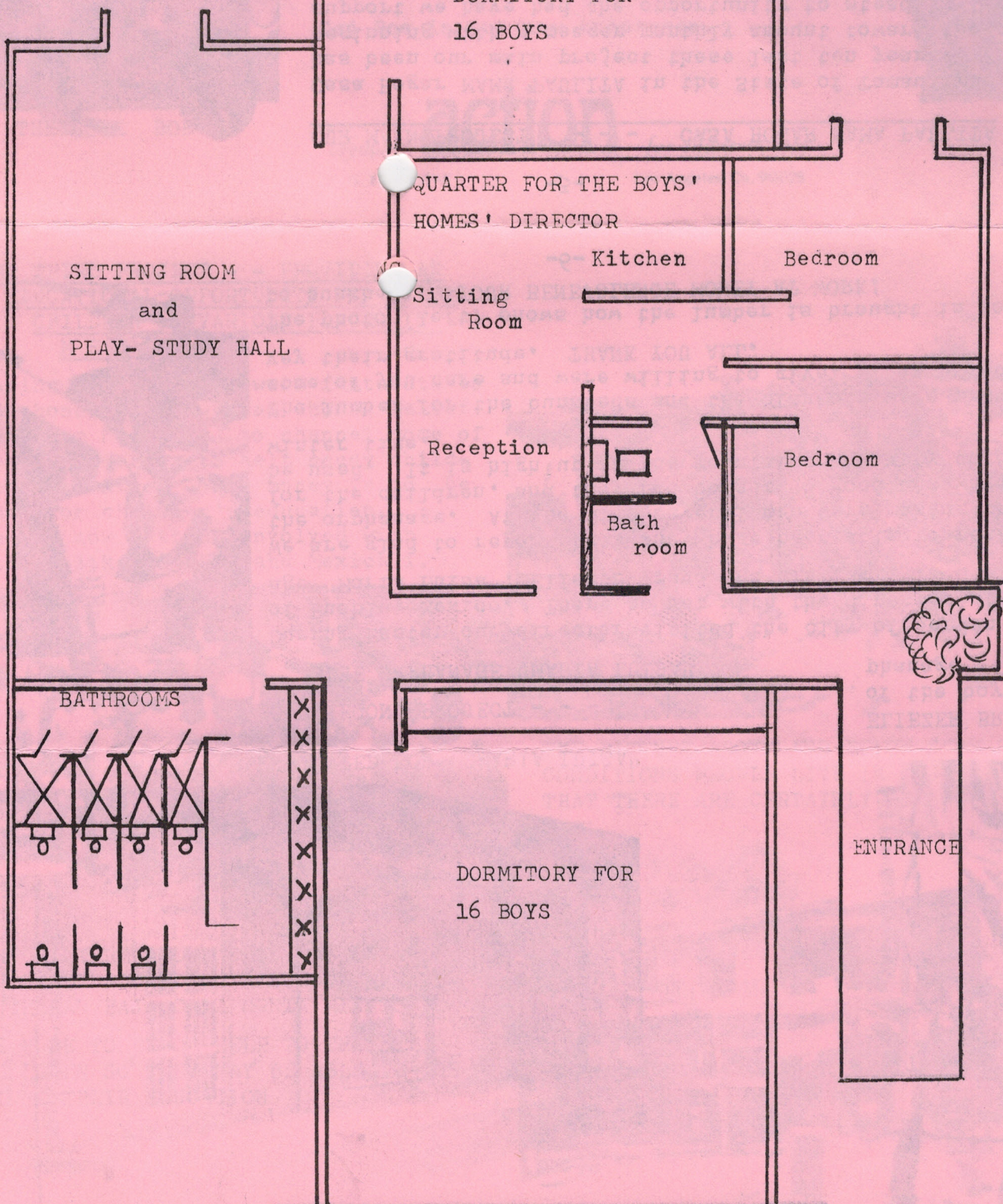

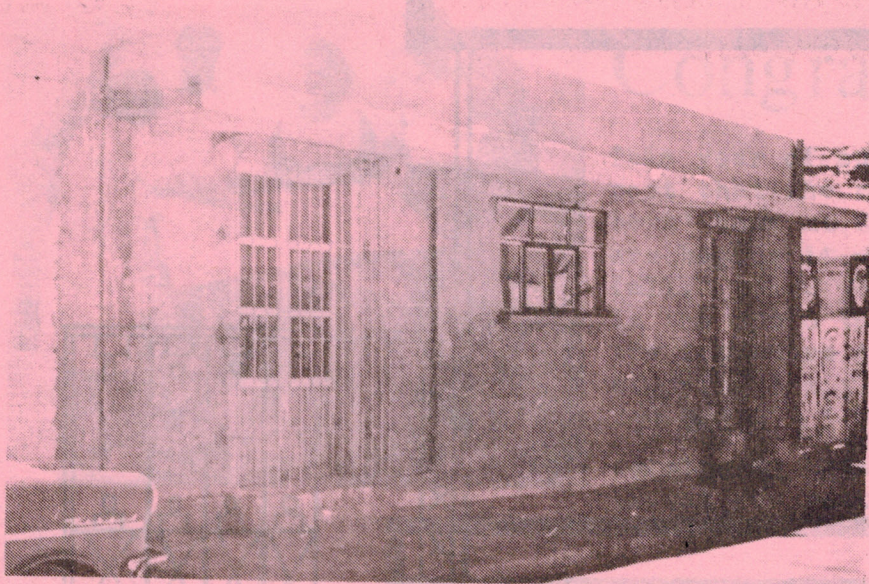

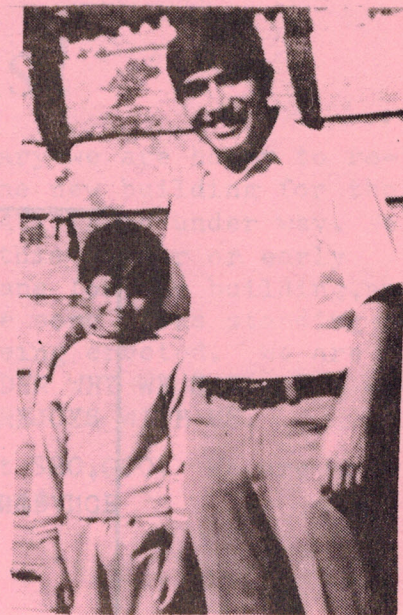

During Easter our director visited the city of Serdan in the state of Puebla, Mexico. There he met with the director of the orphanage "Maria Luisa", Eliezer Bravo and his family.

We are glad to report that they have been able to rent a house for the orphanage. At the time several men were making the bunkbeds for the children, and they had bought 45 good and warm blankets to be used. It is high up in the mountains and very cold during the winter time.

The lumber for the bunkbeds and the blankets were provided because some of you care and were willing to give. They asked us to convey their gratitude. THANK YOU ALL.

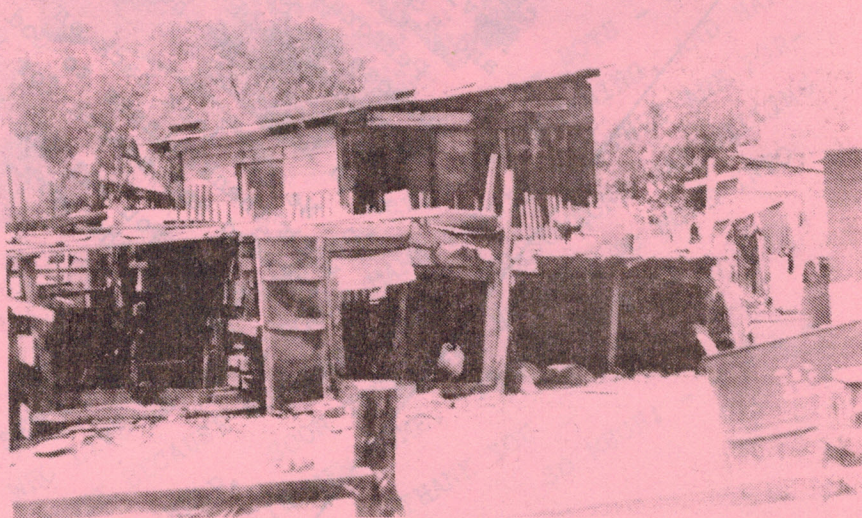
