

Isaiah, the Prophet, predicted more than 700 years before Christ was born: "A little Child shall lead them" (to God's perfect life here on earth and into eternity.)




FROM THE HOMES

Mama Paulita Home for Children, El Limon, Tamps.

The close to 45 Children are anticipating Christmas with practice of songs and performances. They will have many visitors to see them at the home and in the church in Mante.

The picture shows Nancy helping with homework. She is one of the three directors that live at Mama Paulita. Every school day Nancy helps with homework. A certain hour is set aside when all the children gather in the dining hall to do assigned lessons. Usually, two or more adults also help. When finished, free time is enjoyed until chores and meals are scheduled. Nancy also is the "Mother" for the girl's dorm.

The children enjoy the lively Worship Time at the home on Wednesday nights. Worship is led by the directors, Fernando and Yuridia.





Esperanza Home for Children, Bonfil, Q. Roo, near Cancun

About 15 children live at this home now. The house parents, Pastor Ascencio and Esther Mancilla, also supervise an independent new church in Cancun. On Sundays the children crowd into the Pastor's van and become part of about 200 worshippers.

SHELTER FOR YOUNG CHILDREN IN MONTERREY, NL.

It is hard to imagine young children being abandoned. They are all so precious. But with a very high unemployment rate in the cities, (sometimes more than 50%,) what can a mother of several children do? Especially if she is a single parent. She needs to look for work, she needs child care, and money for a place to live. The family she left is often not willing to take her back with children. Her last choice is to place her children in a Charitable Home, look for work and leave with a promise to come back for them soon. After waiting for mother a long time, the memory of her fades. Happily, the memory can be eased by the new care givers supported by you, the Donors!
