The Shelter in Monterrey...surviving Covid-19

Here in the United States, we have all been impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. Children are home from school, parents are working from home, or are essential workers. Many have lost their jobs. It's a tough time for all. The board of Caring Action for Children has been concerned about how our Children's Homes in Mexico have been handling this crisis.

We recently heard from the new director of The Shelter—Guillermo Eduardo Roldan Farias. He told us that on March 16, classes were suspended. Because they have so many children living in close quarters, the director had to find a way to keep children and staff safe. So ten of the children who have relatives near by were sent to live with them. 8 children are still living in The Shelter as they have no where to go.

These remaining 8 children are being cared for by two employees living in the Home. They are staying quarantined—no going in or out. The Director is visiting the Home on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays to check on the children and to bring needed groceries and supplies.

To help out the relatives that have taken in the 10 children, The Shelter is bringing groceries every week to them, and using that opportunity to check on the children and make sure they are well.

Please join us in praying that all the children, students, houseparents, and staff from all our Children and Student Homes are able to stay healthy and safe.


