Children's Homes and Covid-19 in Mexico

Just as we continue to struggle with how the pandemic has affected our schools, employment, and lives, the people in Mexico are having the same struggles. We have had reports from three of our programs.

Mama Paulita—This Home that cares for over 40 children reports that so far none of the staff or children have been infected with the virus. This fall, schools are closed and will remain closed. Public school education will be taught virtually and is going to be broadcasted through national television. Mama Paulita has followed the strict protocols required by the government. They have set up a "sanitizador" so that people going in and out of the facilities can clean their shoes and hands.

La Familia - We just received an update from the La Familia Home...one of the first Children's' Homes that Caring Action for Children started many years ago in Serdan, Puebla.

"With the Corona Virus in full attack mode, we cannot predict what the 2020/2021 school year will look like. Just in case the decision is made to use a virtual classroom this coming year, we have had to raise money to outfit La Familia with internet capability.

We have been blessed with zero Covid-19 cases among our 31 children. However, we did lose a man and his adult son who attended the local church that meets on the second floor at La Familia.

The other news is that one of our students who is now married and attending college gave birth to a little boy on July 4^{th} . She and her husband attend the University in Colima."

The La Familia Home is located now in Colima, and receives support from the Enhance the Dream Foundation.



Please join us in praying for these children, young adults, and the staff members/volunteers who take care of them. We pray for safety and good health, and for financial support for extra needs due to the effects of the pandemic.
