We have received good news from the Mama Paulita Home, located outside the town of Mante in El Limon, Tamps. The Home has been in lockdown throughout the pandemic, but the children's education has not been disrupted. This is because the leadership and board of the Home decided some years ago to build a school on their property. Because of this foresight, the children have been attending school all along this year.

This is such a blessing because all of the schools in Mexico have been closed all year, with only online classes allowed. Needless to say, this has been very harmful to the children in Mexico as many families do not have the equipment or internet access to participate in online school.



There are currently 37 students living on the Mama Paulita campus— 18 girls and 18 boys, between the ages of 5 and 20 years old. These children have no family or have come from an environment of abuse and mistreatment. The older high school age students have been a big help by taking advantage of this unusual time and giving computer classes to the younger children.



The Board of Directors for this Home did a fundraising campaign and were able to purchase a new pair of shoes for each child. You can see their happy faces below!

Why? Because of the children. These precious little ones come from homes where there is abuse, or their parents have disappeared, or they are found on the streets. The little two and three year olds pictured here are from the Shelter in Monterrey– Casa Hogar del Norte. Monterrey is a very large and busy city. If these boys and girls were abandoned here, it would be so easy for them to fall into the wrong hands.

At the Shelter, they are given a safe place to sleep, good meals, an education, and are taught the love of Christ. They have access to doctors and dentists. Psychologists work weekly with them. Volunteers from the universities in Monterrey come and help the children with their homework. Music lessons are provided. A pastor and music leader come regularly to lead chapel services.
